PPW-1Liquid Aircraft Exterior Cleaner

Description

It will remove dirt, oil films, grease, light carbon and exhaust stains from painted or unpainted aircraft surfaces. It is free rinsing to eliminate the danger of paint streaking sometimes encountered in other aircraft cleaners. This product will not leave white deposits or streaks even if allowed to dry on the surface.

- » The cleaner is translucent blue-green in color and is free from any sediment.

Method of Use

Application Methods

- » Spray: Apply with high pressure spray equipment, or with a barrel pump.
- » Immersion: Apply with high pressure pot.

Mixing Instructions

- » Maximum concentration for cleaning in extreme cases: 1 part PPW-1, 5 parts water
- » Commercial aircraft cleaning where the elapsed cleaning time has been less than 25 days: 1 part PPW-1, 10 parts water
- » Normal cleaning of private aircraft where hand washing is the cleaning method used: 1 part PPW-1, 20 parts water
- » For interior cleaning, apply with sponge or cloth; wipe dry: 1 part PPW-1, 3 parts water

Application Instructions

- 1. Allow PPW-1 to sit for 5 to 10 minutes.
- 2. Agitate with suitable brush/mop, and flush off with a large volume of water.

Caution

PPW-1 is non-corrosive to aluminum, magnesium, cadmium, anodized aluminum and ferrous alloys and will not cause hydrogen embrittlement of high strength steel. It will not attack asphalt and is non-crazing to Plexiglas. Refer to product labels and Safety Data Sheets for precautionary and handling information.
